## St Chad's College Guest Rooms

Where a guest room is available, any bookings for overnight stays during term time must be made via a College Officer. The following guidance is in place to ensure fair and appropriate use of such rooms.

## **Priority to book these rooms**

- 1. College Officers (who may also book on behalf of others e.g. College guests)
- 2. Fellows & Tutors
- 3. Students
- 4. Alumni

## **Limits**

- No rooms may be booked more than 12 weeks ahead of time (except by College Officers).
- Fellows & Tutors have first priority to sign up for bookings on <u>Tuesday</u> and <u>Thursday</u>
  evenings. These rooms will be released for general booking if Fellows and Tutors have
  not booked them two weeks ahead of time.
- Guest rooms are not normally intended for students' parents: unless there is a pastoral reason, we assume that parents will normally find accommodation elsewhere in Durham.
- From the first day of the Easter term until the end of the exam period, rooms may only be booked with the approval of the Vice Principal.
- All bookings are subject to the proviso that they may be cancelled at short notice if a room is required for an emergency situation or pastoral crisis.
- The guest rooms are intended for occasional use. As such, bookings will normally only be accepted for one or two nights at a time. Longer periods may be booked by College Officers on behalf of guests where essential.
