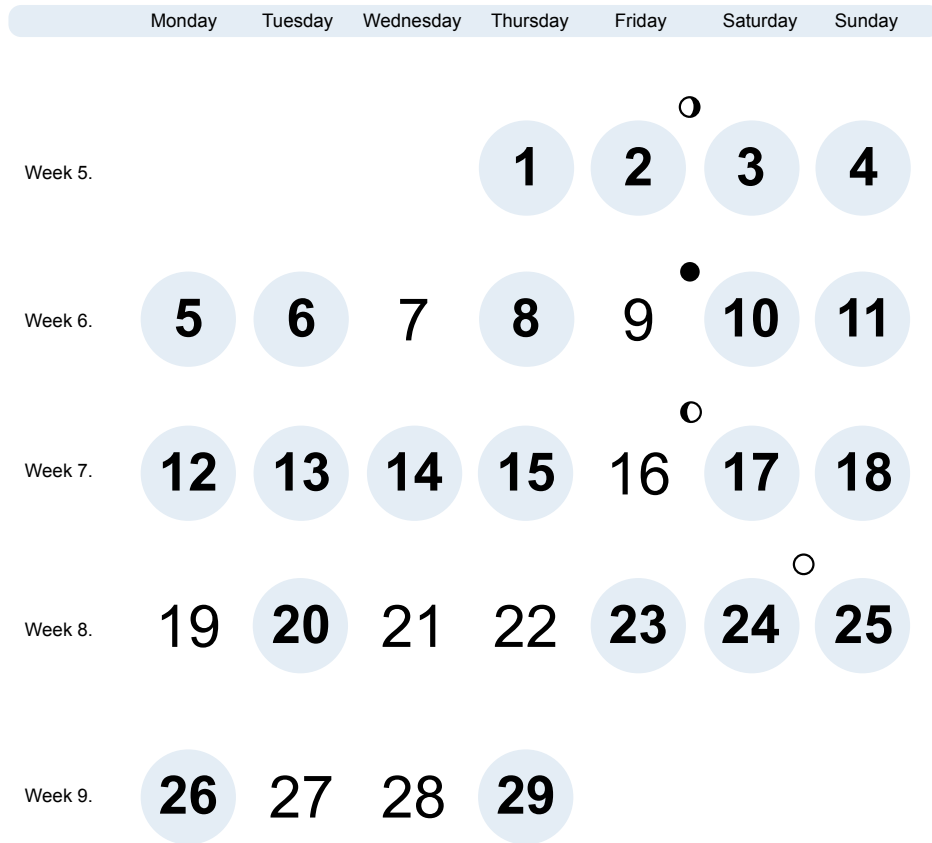
Challenge:

Unconscious Bias.

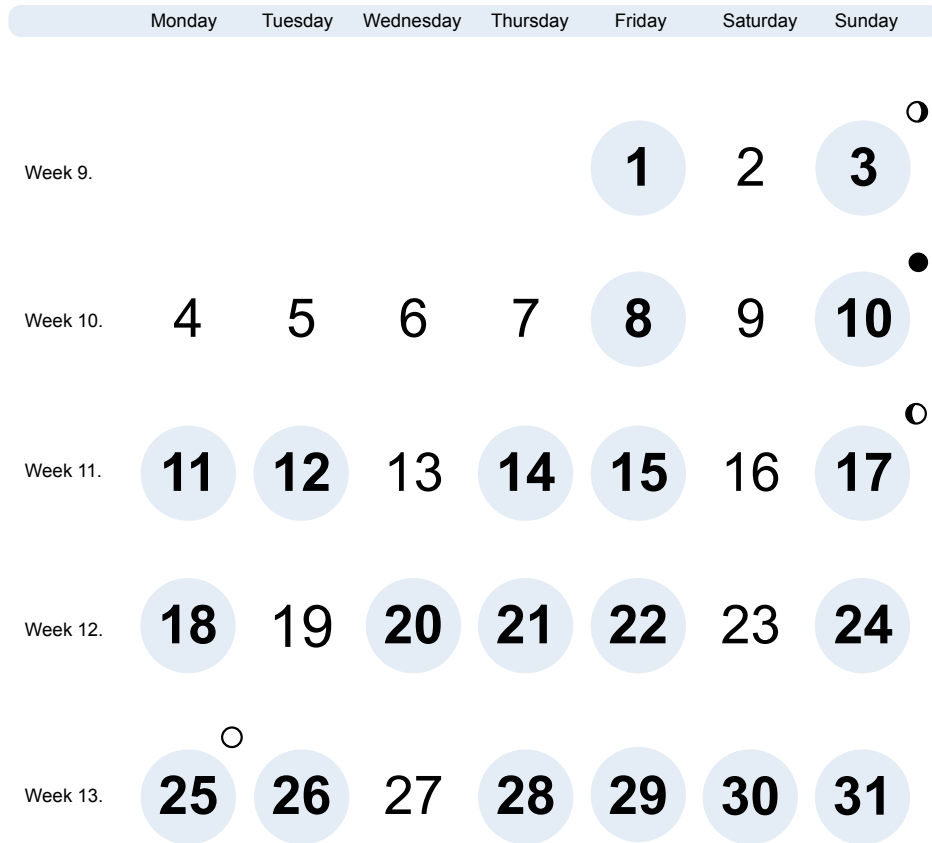
Challenge:

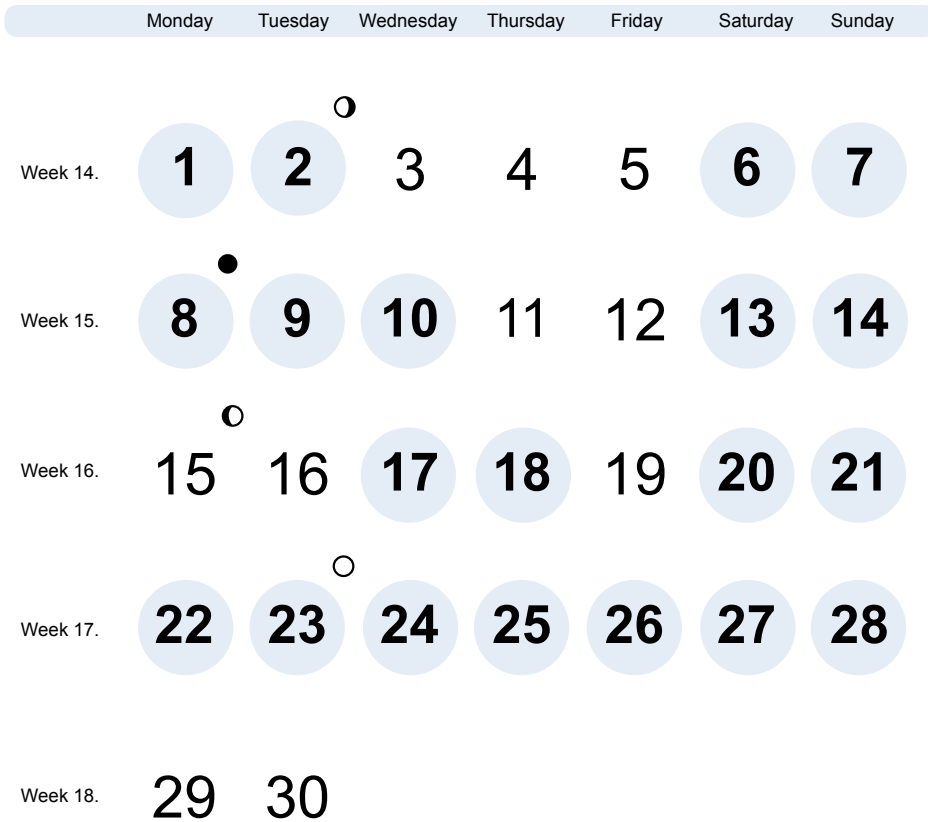
Diversity Training and Education.

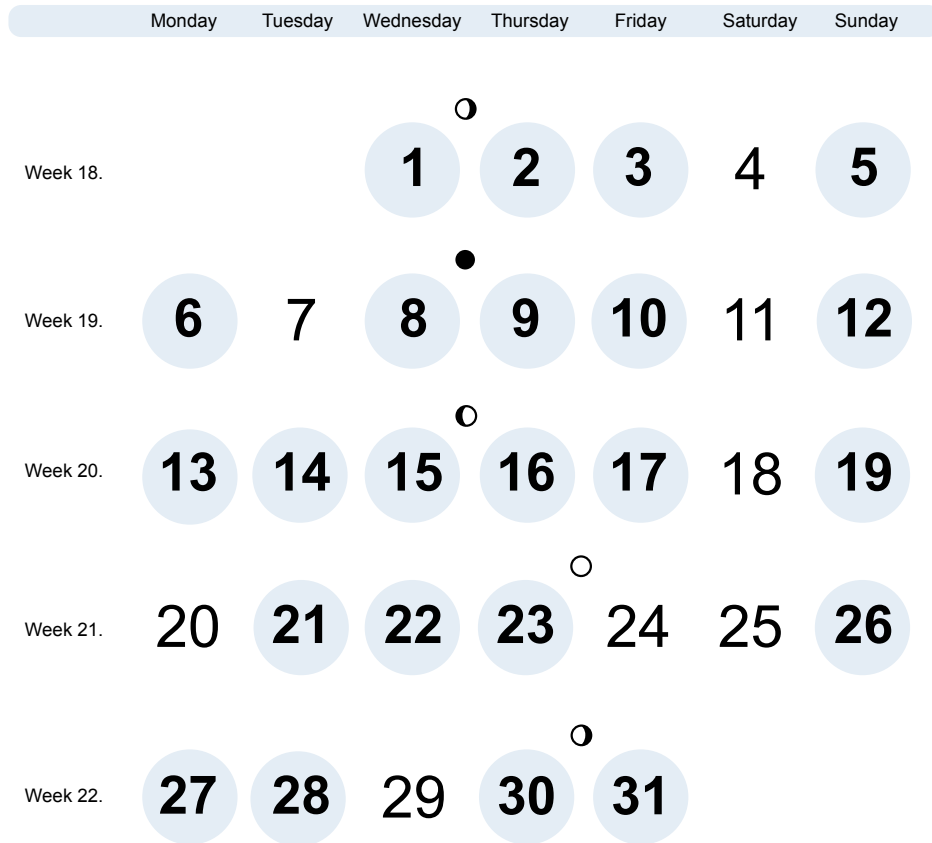

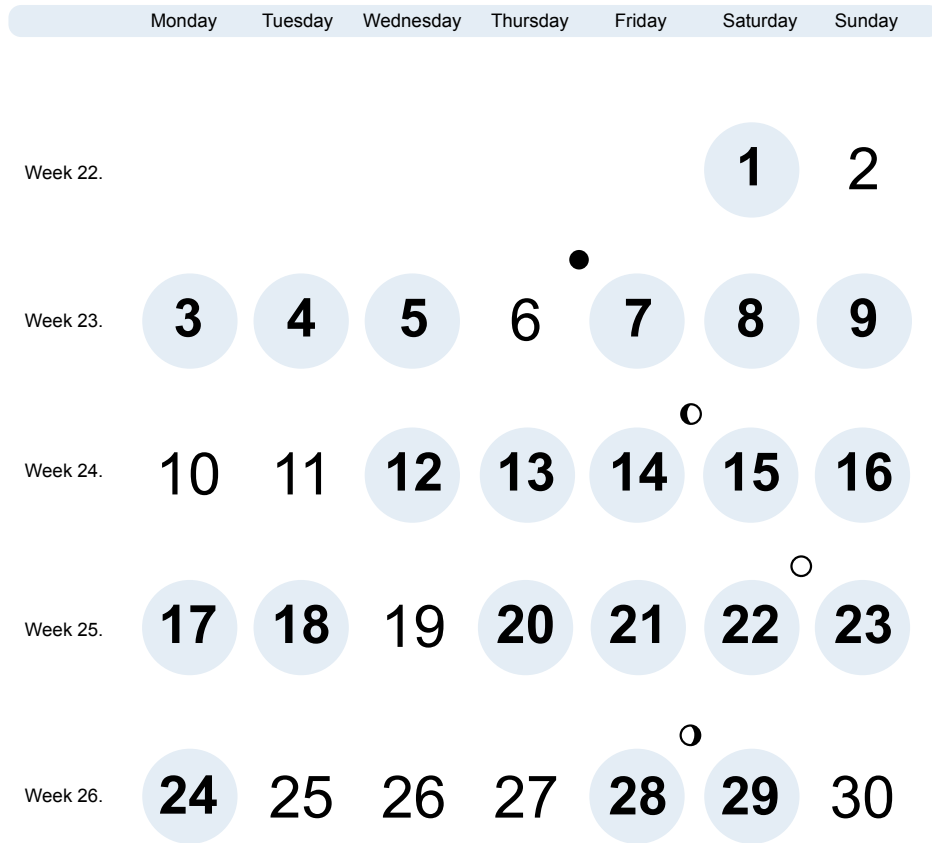
Challenge:

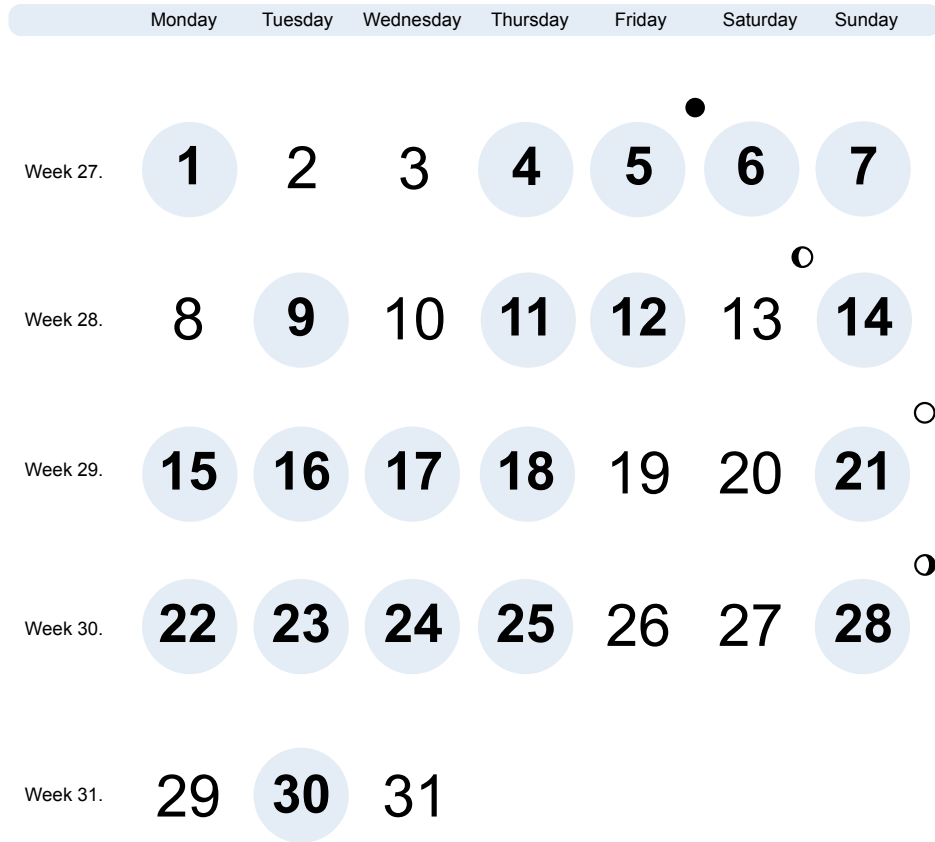

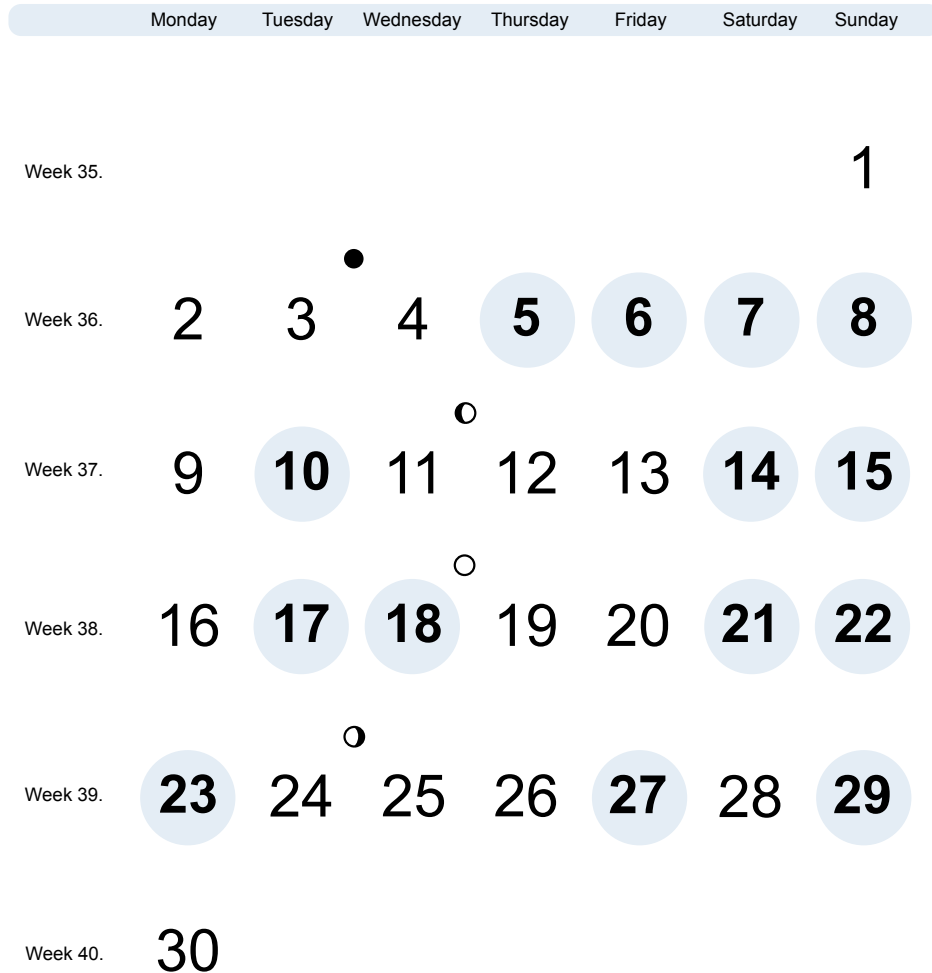

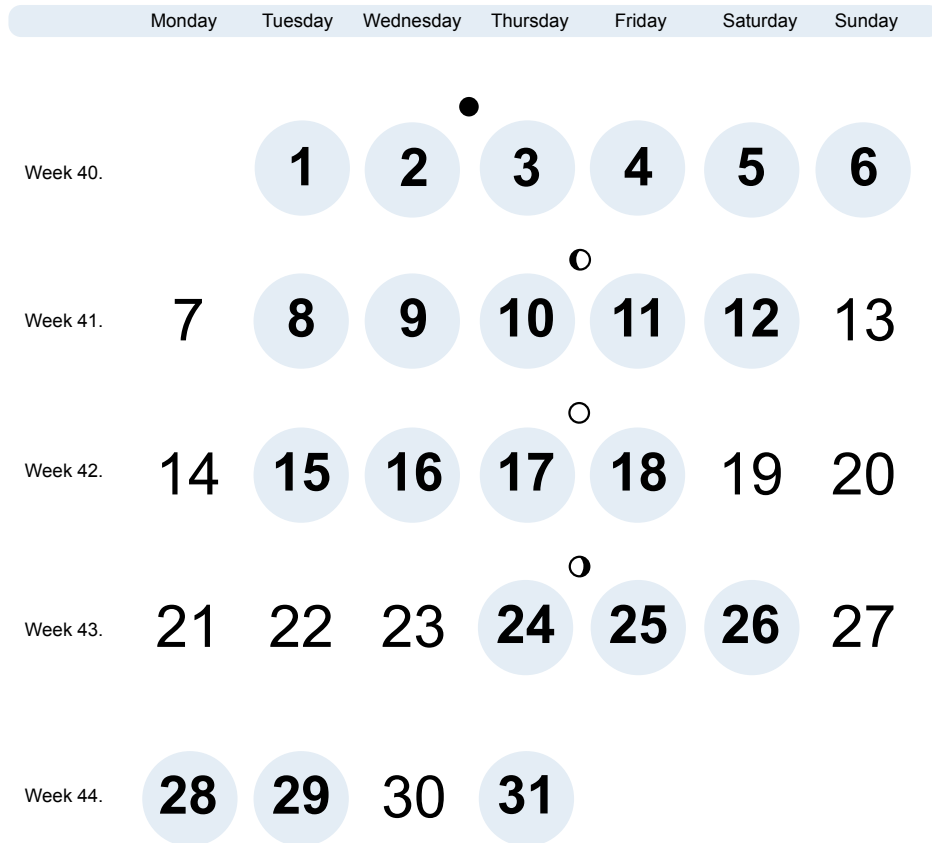
Challenge:

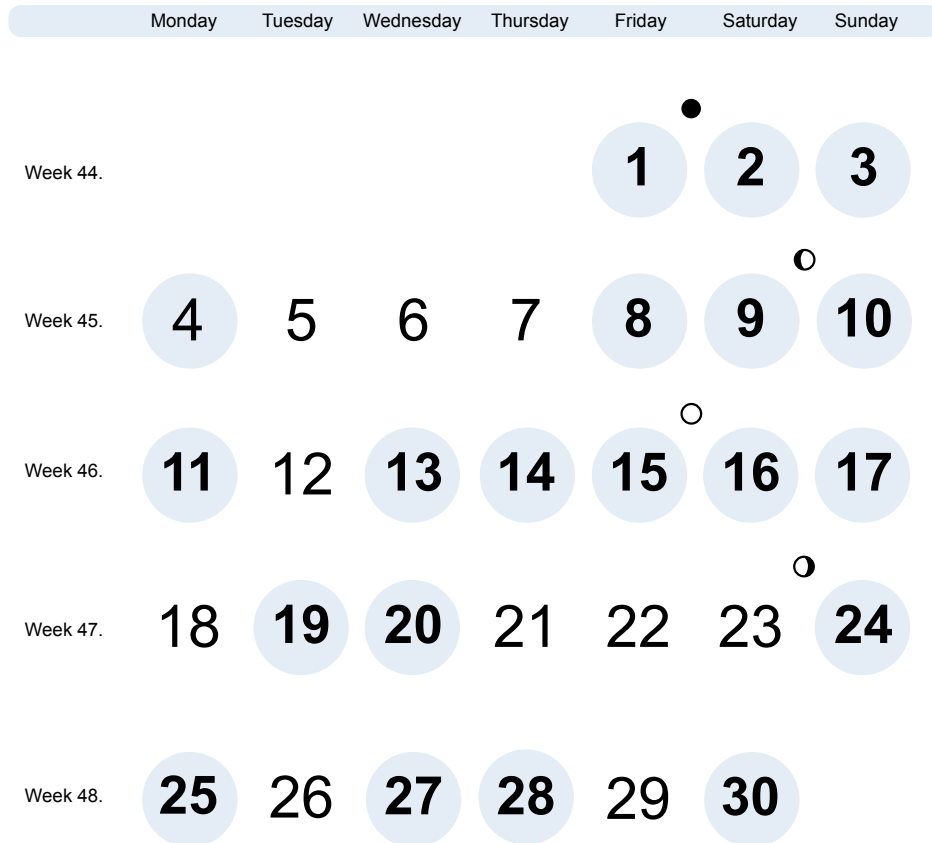

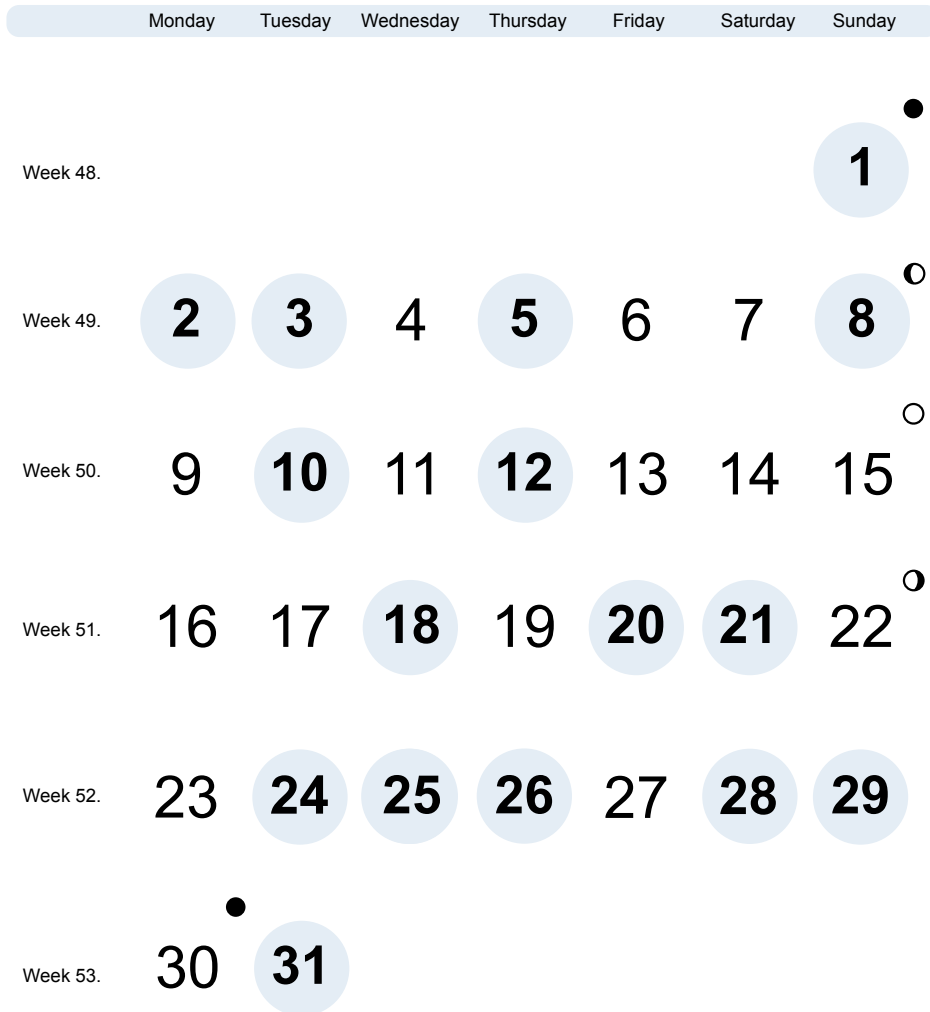
